

Weekly Activities:

The first weekly video will be analyzing cursive letters. I would recommend pausing it between letters to practice writing each. Afterwards, students need to write all letters (lower case and capital), their first and last name, numbers one through ten, days of the week, and the sentence "I miss being at Rizzuto, because my teachers are the best!" in cursive. They can re-watch the video and use the pictures of my journal and other pages to help them complete the work throughout the week. They will have to send me a picture through Class Dojo.
